## You are planning to attract or organize an international event to Montréal

#### The event meets the following criteria:

- Has a minimum of 300 participants or 400 room nights
- Draws at least 50% of its participants from outside of Québec
- Rotates between at least three different countries
- Includes a minimum three-night stay



## Montréal is already confirmed as the host city for the event or the event doesn't meet the eligibility criteria

#### **Services offered:**

- Recommandation of potential venues and/or hotels
- Advisory service tailored to the scale of the event
- Access to a promotional materials toolkit

Our services are limited when Montréal is chosen as the host destination without our involvement.

Please note: The services outlined are not exhaustive. Each project is evaluated on an individual basis before the services offered are confirmed.

## Montréal is not confirmed as the host city for the event

#### **Bidding Process**

- Analysis of bid requirements
- Research for potential venues, hotels, and partners
- Evaluation of financial assistance
- Production of bid documents
- Assistance with presentations
- Coordination of site inspection

### If the financial responsibility lies with the local organization committee, you receive:

- Access to professional consultation services (from 5 h to 15 h, maximum);
- Assistance with a preliminary budget;
- A financial offer.
