The Stade Saputo was built for the CF Montréal squad of the Major League Soccer (MLS), and is dedicated to promoting and developing soccer competitions at the regional, provincial, national and international levels. Inaugurated in 2008, it has been renovated twice since—in 2012 and 2017.

The stadium is located on the former track and field practice site of the 1976 Summer Olympic Games, and its west side offers spectators a view of the Olympic Stadium's majestic inclined tower.
