



CONTEST RULES

« Consumer satisfaction form – MTLàTABLE, Off Trail Edition »

1. CONTEST PERIOD

The Contest runs from Wednesday, June 23rd, 2021 at 12:00:01 a.m. (time in Montréal, Québec, Canada) to Monday, October 25th, 2021 at 11:59:59 p.m. (time in Montréal, Québec, Canada).

2. ELIGIBILITY

The Contest is open to anyone who has reached the age of majority in their province, state or territory of residence at the time of entry, except employees, agents and representatives of Tourisme Montréal or the suppliers of Prizes, advertising agencies or other companies involved in this Contest, as well as members of their immediate family or persons domiciled at their residence. Do not enter this Contest if you are not eligible to participate.

3. HOW TO ENTER

To enter the draw, fill out the [online entry form](#) before Monday, October 25th, 2021 11:59:59 p.m. (time in Montréal, Québec, Canada). One entry per person. Contestants must provide their email address, place of residence and telephone number. No purchase necessary.

4. DESCRIPTION OF THE PRIZES

Four (4) prizes having an approximate total value of \$250 each: SAQ - Panier Découverte

5. DRAW

The winners will be selected by random draw. The draw will take place on Friday, October 26th, 2021 at the offices of Tourisme Montréal located at 800 René-Lévesque Blvd. West, Suite 2450, Montréal, Québec. If a selected contestant is deemed ineligible, that person shall be disqualified and Tourisme Montréal shall draw another name.

Winners will be drawn among all eligible entries received during the Contest Period for:

- Four (4) Prizes (see the Description of the Prizes section above)

6. AWARDING OF PRIZES

The selected contestant shall be informed by email.

To be declared a winner, a selected contestant must sign and return, within seven (7) business days, the Declaration and Release Form prepared by the Contest Organizers who shall, among other things, require the contestant to (i) correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question without the use of a electronic device or other type of assistance; (ii) grant all intellectual property rights, including copyrights in his/her entry, and waive all moral rights in his/her entry in favour of the Contest Organizers; and (iii) agree to indemnify the Releasees from any claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses related to the use of his/her entry, including and without limitation, any claim that his/her entry would violate a third party's property rights. reasonable restrictions on the availability or usage of the Prize and (b) substitute the Prize or a component thereof with a Prize or Prize component(s) of equal or greater retail value, including a cash award, but at the Contest Organizer's sole discretion; (iii) By accepting the Prize, the winner agrees to waive recourse if the Prize or a component thereof does not prove satisfactory, either in whole or in part.

Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Contest Organizers disclaim liability for awarding a Prize to anyone who could have contributed to the development of the contest entry and assumes no responsibility for any person entitled to redeem the Prize along with the winner.

7. ACCEPTANCE OF PRIZE

The Prize must be accepted as awarded; it cannot be exchanged for cash, in whole or in part. The Prize may not be substituted for another Prize, except at the sole discretion of the Contest Organizers, who reserve the right to substitute any component of the Prize for another Prize of equal or greater value. The Prize is not transferrable to another person. Refusal to accept a Prize releases the Contest Organizers from any obligation related to the Prize.

8. PUBLICITY

Before being declared a winner, the selected contestant shall authorize the Contest Organizers and their representatives to use, if necessary, his/her name, likeness and/or hometown for promotional purposes without further payment.

9. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

All intellectual property, including, without limitation, all trademarks, trade names, logos, designs, promotional materials, web pages, source code, drawings, illustrations, slogans and representations are owned or licensed by the Contest Organizers and/or members of their group or is used under licence. All rights are reserved. Unauthorized copying or use of any copyrighted material or intellectual property without the express written consent of its owner is strictly prohibited.

10. LANGUAGE DISCREPANCY

In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between the terms and conditions of these Rules and disclosures or other statements contained in any Contest-related materials, including, social media posts, point of sale, television, print or online advertising, the terms and conditions of these Rules shall prevail.

11. OTHER

- a) All contestants agree to be bound by the official Contest Rules. Contestants who do not abide by the official Contest Rules shall be disqualified. Contestants also agree to be bound by the decisions of Tourisme Montréal. Such decisions will be considered final and binding and will apply in all matters.
- b) The selected contestant shall provide the Contest Organizers with official proof of age upon request and written confirmation that he/she agrees to the official Contest Rules. Failure to do so shall result in his/her disqualification. If this occurs, a new random draw shall be held until the Prize is awarded.
- c) The odds of a contestant's entry being selected for a Prize depends on the number of eligible entries registered during the Contest Period.



- d) In the event that the Contest Organizers are unable to award the Prize for reasons of force majeure beyond their control and unrelated to the winner they undertake to award the winner a Prize of equivalent value and nature or, at their sole discretion, the value of the Prize in cash.

Any attempt to deliberately damage the Contest website or to sabotage the legitimate conduct of this Contest constitutes a violation of civil and criminal laws and the Contest Organizers reserve the right to seek damages to the fullest extent permitted by law in the event of any such attempt. When permitted by the Régie, the Contest Organizers reserve the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend this Contest (or amend its Rules) without notice in the event of an incident, printing error, administrative error or other event or for any other reason.
