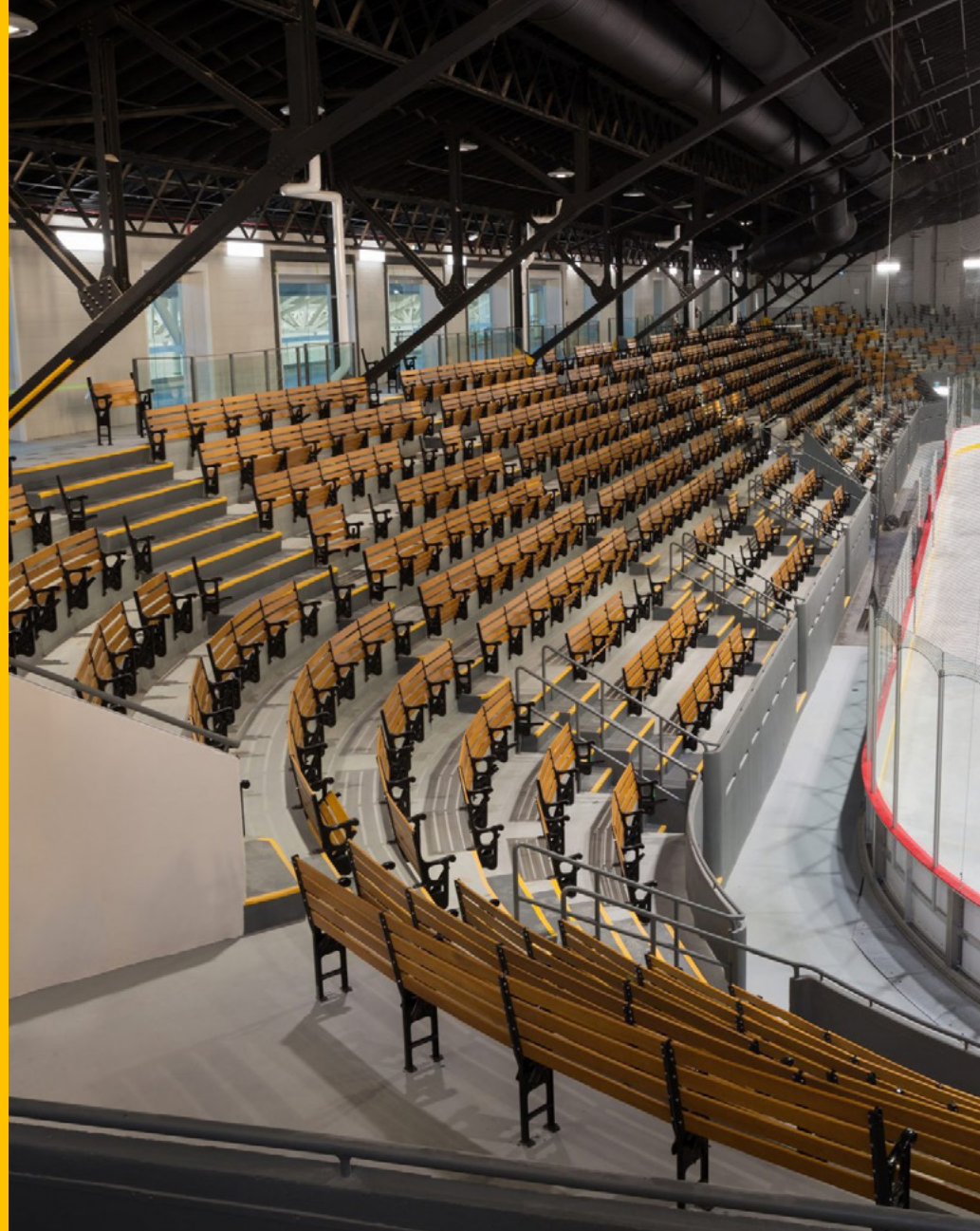

The iconic Auditorium de Verdun, which has been completely restored and transformed, is an outstanding sports venue that includes the Scotty Bowman Arena, and the Denis Savard Arena. This modern, multifunctional LEED Gold-certified sports complex can host sports, cultural and artistic events alike. With an additional 3,181 m<sup>2</sup> (34,240 sq. ft.) of halls, public spaces and meetings room that unify the two arenas, it is the perfect place for any occasion.

The Auditorium de Verdun is the proud home of the city's brand-new Montréal Alliance basketball team. The Alliance is the ninth franchise to join the Canadian Elite Basketball League (CEBL), the country's first professional basketball league, which was founded in 2017 and started play in 2019. Sports fans now get to watch the best professional basketball in Canada outside of the NBA in the top-notch facilities of one Montréal's most historic sports venues.
